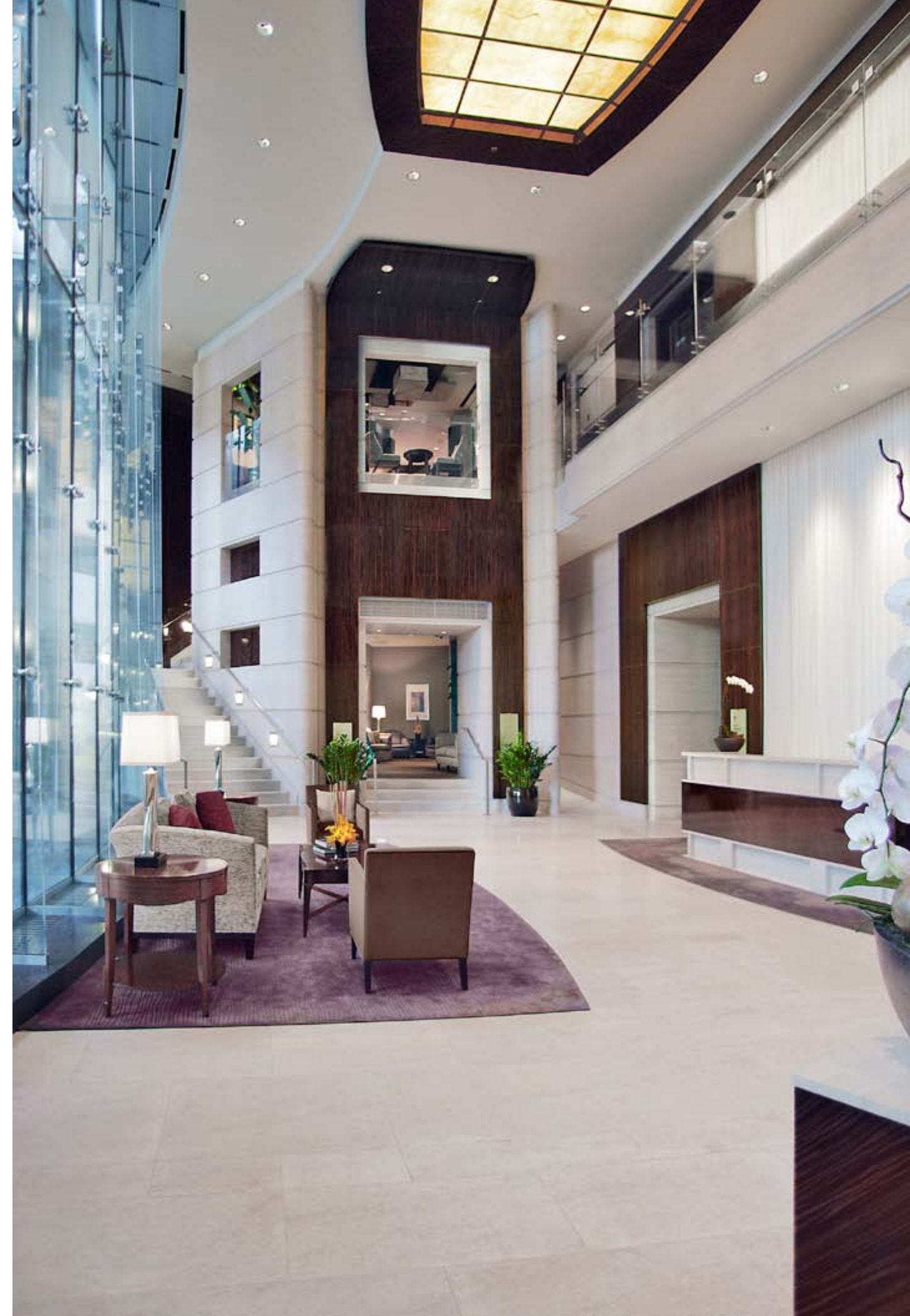
The Trump International Hotel and Tower in Chicago is skyscraper and hotel-condominium combined into the quintessential 21st century experience in luxury. The building, named after real estate developer Donald Trump, was designed by architect Adrian Smith and soars an ambitious 92-stories into the stratosphere above Chicago's Gold Coast, Lake Michigan, and the spectacular Magnificent Mile. As the tenth tallest building in the world, Trump Tower includes, from the ground up, the now famous four-star Chicago restaurant, Sixteen, along with upscale retail space, luxury condominiums and perhaps the most innovative 339 guest rooms in the world.



Considered the ultimate in Business Luxury, we were lured into the Trump Tower by its four-star restaurant, Sixteen. In fact, Sixteen was the most anticipated restaurant to open in the city of Chicago in recent memory. Chef Brunacci, who, during the course of his 20-year career, has garnered experience in some of the world's most distinguished restaurants, changes the menu twice a week and never offers the same creative dish twice. For the gourmand Chef, Brunacci offers a Tasting Menu that changes daily offering the rare chance to experience masterfully crafted dishes that are truly superb. A sommelier complements each culinary creation with suggestions from over 500 labels focusing on American wines. On occasions rare vintages will be offered allowing you to savor private auctioned labels that are aged to perfection.



Rebar, located on the property's Mezzanine Level, offers a venue for a city that appreciates a sophisticated social mix. In addition to a wide range of music, people and events, Rebar presents an extensive mixology program—called Liquid Kitchen—with emphasis placed on the use of fresh juices, mixers, herbs, spices and edible flowers. The wine list focuses on Champagne and sparkling wine primarily available by the half-bottle and by the glass, as well as 15 sake selections. An ever-evolving menu offering Neo Japanese fare created by Executive Chef Frank Brunacci completes the picture.





The (23,000 square-foot) Spa at Trump includes 11 spa treatment rooms offering an array of massages, facials, relaxation programs and signature beauty treatments for women, men and couples, in addition to Swiss and Vichy showers and hydrotherapy tubs. With a Spa Cuisine Menu and several distinct relaxation spaces, The Spa at Trump provides an all-encompassing experience for individual guests, as well as business retreats, bridal showers and other gatherings. Additionally, 53 spa guest rooms, the largest quantity of rooms in the United States solely dedicated to a luxury spa getaway—give new meaning to the term “urban retreat”.

As guests of the hotel we we’re greeted with the utmost attention and care. Spacious guest quarters feature 10-foot, floor-to-ceiling windows affording breathtaking views of the Chicago River and city skyline. Contemporary furniture graces the living areas and bedrooms. To further optimize their restful experience, guests may also choose from an extensive Pillow Menu. Fully equipped kitchens feature Italian wood cabinetry by Snaidero and stainless steel appliances including a microwave and a dishwasher and cook top by Miele. The room’s Sub-Zero refrigerator also serves as the mini-bar, offering—in addition to snacks, water and juices—half-sized bottles of wine and spirits. Bernadaud china and Spigeleau stemware fills the cabinetry in all guest rooms. The limestone, five-fixture bathroom features custom vanities, separate stall shower, deep soaking tubs, in-mirror television portal and premium fixtures offering lighting and window treatments that can be controlled at the touch of a button. And every room features an electronic “Do Not Disturb” option that automatically disables the doorbell to each guest room. Even the Attaché Guest Services is available around the clock to serve guests’ needs before, during and after their stay. Trump Attachés are on hand to attend to personal preferences—from satisfying pre-arrival grocery and floral requests, to arranging for laundry and dry cleaning, personal shopping services, or preparation of personalized business cards and stationery.

Indeed, Mr. Trump has recreated the future from the very building blocks of a refined and elegant past. And whether your errand is for business, pleasure or even a special occasion, all are found encapsulated in the celebration that is Trump International Hotel and Tower Chicago. CHARITAN
